Looking for a way to help some of our own who need financial assistance? In May churches throughout the N.C. Conference of the United Methodist Church are given the opportunity to support the Mother's Day offering. The Mother's Day offering provides financial and personal resources for residents who can no longer fully pay their way. In many cases these residents have no other means of support and often no family. But the Mother's Day offering doesn't have to be taken only on the actual day. It can be taken any time.

It takes \$100 to subsidize one day of care for benevolent residents. Most of these residents are in the 88+ age category and are residing in independent and assisted living. They are not eligible for Medicaid or any other government program. Those who are in the nursing center receive only a portion of the daily cost from Medicaid. The benevolence fund underwrites the rest.

Some of the people who benefit from the proceeds raised are senior retired pastors, or their wives, who served before there was a pension plan for retired pastors.
